1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Rangemaster X3 Pro/.Net is the only all-in-one range automation system including the best payment/accounting system available for modern shooting ranges.

Due to powerful and easy-to-use Software **Rangemaster X3 Pro/.Net** System is a unique tool for complete and easy range administration and management.

Features included to the X3 Pro/.Net basic set:

- Shooters' database
- Complete reporting
- Administration of clay target launchers (thrown/fill/no bird/etc.)
- Separate accounting for each customer showing all transactions
- Chip card administration with loss protection
- Administration of shooting modes
- Complete range administration
- Payment administration + accounting
- Trap charge control
- Separate price models according to customer groups, weekdays and etc.
- Access to software only by predefined access-levels
- Multi language support: English, German, Russian
- Dynamic pricing solution: different prices for different shooting disciplines for up to 26 customer groups, with different prices for each customer group for every weekday and 2 different prices in the morning and in the afternoon (for each day).



Accounting system

Anyway if a customer loses his chip card he should always report to the range administration to have it locked to avoid any fraudulent activities.

Payment System

The Rangemaster X3 Pro/.Net system offers following payment options – assignable to each

customer/shooter separately:

- Prepaid:

The customer puts an amount of money on his account and this amount is available to the

shooter for any type of clay shooting on his shooting range. But he can not shoot if amount of

money on his account is not enough for the next shooting round.

- Shooting with debit (Post-Charge):

The account of a shooter with the "post-charge" option set does not have to have money on

the account at all and the account can be loaded at any time later but he can not exceed a

credit shown. It means he can not exceed his credit limit which can be set for each shooter

individually.

- Free-of-charge:

All transactions are logged/reported, but does not have any influence on the shooter's

account/balance.

Shooter can shoot for free in payment mode (notwithstanding his current account state), only

time, date, range and discipline will be added to the account, but no change to shooter's

like fingerprint sensors could be used.

chip cards can be directly printed from the software and adding shooter's picture is also

possible.

It is also possible to lock stolen or lost chip cards. The shooter's credit is no longer accessible

with the locked chip card and can be re-accessed when a new chip card is assigned.



1.2 MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR RUNNING ADMINISTRATIVE PROGRAM SALES.EXE

- Rangemaster X3 USB Chip drive attached to COM Port COM9
- Rangemaster Server up and running (ffserver with 192.168.0.1 IP address)




- The workstation has to be connected to the same network as the server
- The client's IP address is within the range 192.168.0.4 to 192.168.0.19



2. LOGGING IN

There are two ways to log in to the program:

- by entering your administrative PIN-code
- by inserting the administrative chip card into the chip card reader



To make an administrative card use any chip card (shooter's used/old chip card):

- First insert the chip card into the chip card reader

Orange light: card is being processed

Red light: card is inserted in the wrong side or you insert a new chip card

Green light: everything is correct and you can continue

Issuing chip cards and passwords should be entered by System Administrator:

Main Menu → System Administrator (menu list on the left) → USERS / PRIVILEGES

Here you can do all necessary settings for the chip card.



Status: green - online / red - offline


Last time alive column shows when the layout/monitor was active last time.

RBSD-Managment is a remote reboot and shut down button.

- number of shooters

- clays thrown


3.2.1 GLOBAL-VIEW

It is an option program for displaying the shooting progress on up to 6 layouts – to be viewed on an HD-Monitor only.



3.2.2 LIVE-VIEW

Using the Live-View option you can see who is shooting on the layout (Squad/Round/Start time/ Names of the shooters with Bib numbers/Nationality/ Hits/misses/Total/R (ranking)





3.2.3 RESET RANGE

This feature should be used to reset data only if you have a layout marked as **busy** from last day shooting. This old data is displayed only if there was no database clean up (**Last Sys-Clean-Up**) at 06.31 in the morning.

E.g. here you can see an old competition round is still shown on Range 1.

In this case use **Reset range** option to clear it before starting a new competition/training

NOTE: This feature will never reset a round or abandon a shooting progress







All you need is to:


- insert the chip card into a chip card reader

5.1 SHOOTER'S DETAILS

To open shooter's personal card with all details click twice his name or mark his record and press **Shooter's details.**



If you need to add or edit any information in this card press **Edit data** first.

WARNING: While editing shooter's data shooter cannot register to shoot with a chip card!



Print chip card:

This feature allows to put the shooter's photo and name on his future chip card in case you have a special chip card printer. As a front side (background) you can use your own design/layout.

E.g. name of your shooting ground and etc.



To insert your own picture as a background:

- Go to C:\Rangemaster folder
- open background1.jpg document and insert your own image

If this option with bonification is tagged and a shooter puts money into his account using cash/credit card/ATM he gets additional money/bonification on his account (according to the percentage shown).

E.g. shooter puts 500 Euro into his account and he has 5% bonification granted, he gets 525 Euro in total added into his account.

5.1.1 MODES OF PAYMENT ALLOWED:

- Pre-paid:

The customer puts an amount of money on his account and this amount is available to the shooter for any type of clay shooting on his shooting range. But he can not shoot if amount of money on his account is not enough for the next shooting round.

E.g.:525 euro is on the account:

It is possible to use all 525 euro, but if remaining credit is 5 euro and the next round costs 6 euro – shooter is not allowed to register for a new round.

- Post-Charge (pay later):

The account of a shooter with the "post-charge" option does not have to have money on the account at all and the account can be loaded at any time later but he can not exceed a credit shown.

- Free of charge:

All transactions are logged/reported, but does not have any influence on the shooter's account/balance.

Shooter can shoot for free in payment mode (notwithstanding his current account state), only time, date, range and discipline will be added to the account, but no change to shooter's

- **Multi-charge per round** untagged allows shooter register only once in each round with his chip card
- Account locked if tagged shooter cannot register and shoot in pay mode.
- Credit ("-" if no) shows how much additional credit is granted to the shooter.

This field can be used only together with the field **shooting with credit** tagged.

This option is necessary when shooters are shooting on a layout where SSA mode is activated (**Sysadmin – Shooting modes allowed**). This mode allows to register for the shooting in a payment mode only when instructor is registered. It is necessary for supervision of shooters by their instructor and for accounting, in case instructor is payed according to his working hours and etc.

5.1.2 DELETING A SHOOTER FORM THE MAIN DATABASE

- Click Edit data button
- Press Delete Shooter

WARNING: There is no further access to his record and all of his account data, if shooter is deleted.

Be sure that customer is deleted only if he passed away

To delete shooters a special privilege is needed (Sysadmin→ Users/privileges)

5.2 ADMINISTRATE CHIP CARD

Shooter returns card: removes assigned number and card is locked, so it might be formatted

and used again.

The initial amount taken from customer's account (when his chip card was initially issued to

him) will be refunded again (in favor of his account).

Assign new card to shooter: Insert a new (formatted) chip card and press this button to

assign a new chip card to the shooter selected. The amount for issuing a chip card will be

taken from his account.

Card is damaged/ not readable: (= shooter returns card): In the rare case when chip is not

readable, press this button in order to refund the amount taken from the account, remove

the old signature (stored) from shooter's record in order to be able to assign a new chip card

to this customer.

Shooter has lost card (remove assignment, lock card): In case a shooter called and

reported that he has lost his chip card, administrator should immediately enter his account

and press this button.

As a result credit status will be frozen until customer gets a new chip card assigned to his

record.

Take back locked card and credit amount: adds deposit (amount the shooter was charged

when received the chip card) in favor of shooter's account. It adds a line in the shooter's


account sheet that the card is taken back and certain amount is given back. Plus it adds a line

in a card log with card taken back.

5.3 SHOOTER'S ACCOUNT



Button **Delete turnover**, **print accounting report** erases all transactions from customer's account; his credit will not be touched and preserved. Administrator can use this option to delete data of the customer at the beginning of a new year. He can always restore this data by pressing **Re-organize** button, but customer will not be able to print this data by his own.

Re-organize: record can be recuperated again for a new print of customer's account.

Payback credits, delete turnovers, print account sheet If shooter wants to cancel his account and have his credit returned to him, press this button. As a result you will have two printouts of account sheets. One should be signed by a customer and kept by administrator.


NOTE: The chip card has to be taken back first!



5.4 SHOP SALES BUTTONS

These buttons can be used only if you have **Rangemaster Gunshop** installed.

5.5 LOAD ACCOUNT



Using **+ load account** button administrator puts money or gives credit to the customer/shooter.

NOTE: when putting money add the amount into the **Amount filed without** minus.

Fill **Reason for crediting** field if necessary.

Types of payment:

- Cash
- Non cash crediting
- ATM/Card



- Voucher
- Bank collection

When the amount is entered press Confirm

NOTE: When entering amount please use the following format: 5000, not: "5.000,00"

5.6 DEBIT ACCOUNT




Credit on a chip-card shows current amount of money on shooter's account.







As a result on the touch screen layout computer we can see **Olympic trench** discipline with all modes.


